Gift Aid Envelopes

It's that time again.....the start of a new tax year and the opportunity for all of us to think about our weekly donations to the parish.

For those of you who already generously give through the Gift Aid scheme - thank you; your donations make a tremendous difference to our parish finances.

Your new envelopes are ready to be collected from the Hall Foyer after Mass on 2nd & 3rd April 2016 - please remember to pick them up. This helps our Parish Organiser enormously with his work at this time on the scheme.

For those of you who wish to donate using the Gift Aid scheme - forms are ready for you to fill in again in the Foyer Hall & boxes of envelopes are ready for you to take with you.

PLEASE CONSIDER using Gift Aid for all of your donations - if you are a UK taxpayer and pay enough tax to cover your donations then there is nothing else you have to do or pay.

This is a gift from the Government - it's not often the Tax People give you money back so let us make the most of it! For every £1 you give us - we can claim 25p back from HMRC.

You only sign up to give what you can afford and when you can afford it - you are not committed for any particular amount at any particular time but if we have you signed up - anything you give will be gift aided. It is confidential and you won't be asked personal details.

And a final thought on giving....how much to give to our parish? Perhaps you could consider donating the first hour of your week to our work here in Christ - whether this is your pay or your pension or other income you receive in that hour - to support our community of Catholic worshippers here in Canterbury?
